



2011 Spider Lily Eco-Tour Afternoon Agenda (PM)

What do you need to bring? Kayak/canoe, life jacket, paddle, water, snack/lunch, sunscreen, camera, anything else you might want to bring

12:30-1:15 Arrive, unload and deposit boats, paddles, personal flotation devices and other gear in staging area.

(If kayak is rented, please remember to arrive no later than 12:45pm at takeout area to meet with Catawba River Expeditions)

12:30-1:15 Check in at CRF Tent and Sign Releases

(NOTE: Every paddler must check in and sign a CRF release form in order to participate.)

1:15 Shuttle one departs— *Once all the gear you want to take with you on the Eco-Tour is unloaded at the staging area, one person should get in your vehicle and go to the take-out to park your vehicle there. Then, be sure to catch the 1:15pm or 1:30pm shuttle that will return you to the staging area. There will only be two shuttles!*

1:30 Shuttle two departs—see note above at 1:15pm. This is the last shuttle for the PM trip.

1:40 Safety Briefing and Assignment of group leaders—attendance at Safety Briefing is mandatory for all participants.

2:00 Watercraft launching. Once your vessel is launched, please paddle upstream and wait in the calm water upstream of the shoals for all vessels to launch. The Riverkeeper will be the last vessel to launch (blue-marbled Dagger kayak). Once all vessels are launched the Riverkeeper will lead the tour through the shoals down to the lilies.

3:30 Stop all watercraft in the middle of the lilies for message/photos.

4:30-5:00pm Arrive at take out. Load gear, event complete.
